#### Campaign I.

# ONE FUND FOR PEACE IN CYPRUS (OFFPIC)

The take up of the OFFPIC Scheme has so far exceeded our expectations. The intake of subscribers on in the first month of the campaign was greater than set by our modest but realistic campaign organisers.

As well as subscriptions coming from individuals, some as far as Canada and USA, we have also been successful in achieving contributions from British trade unions.

Through the success of the Scheme we intend to establish a permanent base for the FORUM and ensure that we are in a position to appoint at least 2 part time persons on a professional capacity for us. This inevitably would lead to the FORUM being able to implement and achieve most of its objectives.

We call upon those of you yet to complete a standing order form to subscribe to the Scheme to do so soon. Your support is needed now. For £5.00 a month (equaivalent of £1.25p a week) you could help the FORUM achieve the necessary resources to operate on a much more effective way

## ACTION FOR PEACE IN CYPRUS NOW

The growing threat of conflict between Turkey and Greece, the ongoing activities and provocation of chauvinists and nationalists of both sides has become a major concern to all progressive and democratic people of Cyprus.

The continuing threat of war and conflict hanging over the heads of the two communities in Cyprus is doing nothing to help build confidence and a lasting peace on the island.

The FORUM sincerely believes that the great majority of Cypriots, Turkish and Greek Cypriots alike, wish to see a lasting peace on the island and between the two communities.

To demonstrate this the FORUM has begun a petition to raise 5,000 signatures, primarily from both sides of the community but not exclusively, as we also seek support to this campaign from non-Cypriot progressive and democratic minded people.

The right wing nationlists from both sides have already thrown a challenge to us with the start of this campaign that we shall not be able to or allowed to collect no more than 100 signatures let alone 5,000. They claim the great majority of the Cypriots wish to keep things as they are (their words).

We know otherwise and we intend to prove it.

Organisations in Cyprus, from both sides of the island have already gathered hundreds of signatures. By february we intend to reach our target figure and beyond.

# EUROPEAN YOUTH EXCHANGE SCHEME

In conjunction with two partner organisations from Cyprus – 1 from north and 1 from south - the FORUM is involved in a youth exchange project. The Project will involve approximately 30 youths (under 25) and 9 adults, with 10 youths and 3 adults from each of the partner organisations in the Scheme.

A preliminary meeting is arranged for December where 8 representatives of the organisations will gather in London to discuss the details of the Scheme.

The Scheme itself will be in run in April 99 (in Cyprus) and September 99 (in London).
