

Concern for Displaced Cypriots (E.K.E.K.A.) is issuing this pamphlet in order to enlighten Cypriot and British friends alike that the only way forward for the solution of the Cyprus problem is for the removal of all barriers which have been created between Greek and Turkish Cypriots. This pamphlet seeks to illustrate the friendship and co-operation between Greek and Turkish Cypriots — a fact which is stressed time and time again by responsible leaders.

The problem of Cyprus has never been a dispute between the Greek and Turkish Cypriots. It is, in fact, a dispute between the entire population of Cyprus and the invading troops from the Turkish mainland. The Turkish Cypriots are allies in the common struggle for justice in Cyprus; the Turkish Cypriots are to-day, under oppression suffering, firstly under the invading and occupying Turkish troops, secondly by colonists from Turkey, and thirdly by the fascist and terrorist organisation known as the TMT. We believe, that Turkish Cypriots are invaluable allies to Greek Cypriots in the struggle for:-

*the withdrawal of all Turkish and foreign troops;
the Independence of Cyprus;
non-alignment;
the demilitarisation of the island of Cyprus.*

Concern for Displaced Cypriots (EKEKA) hopes that the contents and message of this pamphlet will be appreciated by all democratic and liberal minded people in the U.K. EKEKA further hopes that efforts will be renewed and intensified for more positive and active support and solidarity for the success of the inter-communal talks now taking place in Nicosia.

These talks are centred round a solution based on:-

*the principle of a bi-regional federation;
the elimination of any foreign intervention and influence
on the affairs of Cyprus;
the right of freedom of movement;
freedom of settlement and right of property ownership,*

and for all these principles and rights to be fully guaranteed.

Already prominent democratic and liberal citizens have pledged support as indicated in the recent motion in the House of Commons on 4th February 1981. This motion appears in this pamphlet.

**BARIŞ İÇİN DÜNYA HALKLARININ
PARLAMENTOSUNA KATILAN
KIBRIS TÜRK VE RUM
DELEGASYONLARININ TARİHSEL ÇAĞRISI**


23-27 Eylül 1980 tarihleri arasında Sofya'da (Bulgaristan) toplanan Barış İçin Dünya Halklarının Parlamentosu'na katılan biz Kıbrıslı Türk ve Rum delegeleri; Kıbrıs bunalımının uzaması, Doğu-Akdeniz'in bu hassas bölgesinde barış ve güvenliği ciddi bir şekilde tehdit ettiğinden; sorunun Denktaş-Makarios, Denktaş-Kipriano anlaşmaları ve Kıbrıs'la ilgili B. Milletler kararları çerçevesinde; B. Milletlerin gözetiminde, toplumlararası görüşmeler yoluyla en erken bir zamanda adil bir çözümünden yana olduğumuzu belirtiyoruz.

Toplumlararası görüşmelerin tekrar başlamasını olumlu karşılamaktayız. İki toplum arasındaki karşılıklı güven duygularının gelişmesi en erken bir zamanda bir çözüme varılabilmesi için konuşmacılara yardımcı olmak amacıyla; her iki tarafın çeşitli görüşlere sahip temsilcilerin biraraya gelebilmelerini ve birlikte çareler arayabilmelerini sağlayacak olumlu ortamın yaratılması için pratik tedbirlerin alınmasını talep ediyoruz.

Kıbrıs'ın bağımsızlık, egemenlik ve toprak bütünlüğünden yanayız. Kurulacak olan yeni Federal Cumhuriyet'te; adanın tümünün veya bir kısmının başka bir ülke ile birleşmesine veya herhangi bir şekilde taksimine karşı yeterli güvenlik tedbirlerinin sağlanması talep ediyoruz.

Kıbrıs Türk ve Rumlarına ve bölge halklarına büyük bir tehlike teşkil eden İngiliz üslerinin sökülpü atılması için birlikte savaşacağız.

Bütün Kıbrıs Türk ve Rumlarının özlemi; güzel adamızı bütün yabancı askerden tamamıyla arındırmak, Orta-Doğu'nun bu hassas bölgesinde Kıbrıs'ı bir barış, dostluk ve işbirliği köprüsü haline dönüştürmektir.

WORLD COUNCIL FOR PEACE

Communiqué of the Cypriot Delegation

"We the Cypriot representatives — both Greek and Turkish — who participated in the World Council for Peace (Sophia 23-27 September 1980) consider the perpetuity of the Cypriot Crisis as a threat to peace and stability in the most sensitive area of the Mediterranean, and pledge and support for a speedy and just solution to the Cyprus Problem through the intercommunal talks under the auspices of the United Nations, within the agreed guidelines of the Makarios/Denktaş agreement, Kyriacou/Denktaş accord and the relevant U.N. Resolutions, we greet the resumption of the intercommunal talks, we request that all practical measures be taken to create the atmosphere that will stimulate mutual trust among the communities and ensure that representatives of the communities come together to explore common ground to assist the negotiations for a speedy solution.

We request that the independence, sovereignty, territorial and the political non-alignment of Cyprus be respected, and that a new federated republic be created with adequate guarantees against any possible annexation to any other country of the whole or any part of the island, and denounce partition of any kind.

We shall struggle for the abolition of the British bases which constitute a great threat to the Cypriot people, both Turks and Greeks and to all the countries in the area.

The desire of all Cypriots is to have their beautiful island free from all foreign troops and bases, completely demilitarized, a bridge for peace, friendship and cooperation in this turbulent part of the world.

ΤΟ ΠΛΗΡΕΣ κείμενο, που φέρει τόν τίτλο «Παγκόσμιο Κοινοβούλιο τών Λαῶν γιά τήν Ειρήνη — Διακήρυξη τῆς Κυπριακῆς ἀντιπροσωπείας», έχει ως ἔξης:

«Ἐμεῖς οι Κύπριοι ἀντιπρόσωποι, Ἐλληνες καὶ Τούρκοι, πού συμμετέχουμε στὸ Παγκόσμιο Κοινοβούλιο τῶν Λαῶν γιά Ειρήνη (Σόφια 23—27) Σεπτεμβρίου 1980) θεωρώντας τή διαιώνιση τῆς κυπριακῆς κρίσης σάν μεγάλη ἀπειλὴ γιά τήν εἰρήνη καὶ ὁσφάλεια στήν πιό εὐαίσθητη περιοχή τῆς Ἀνατολικῆς Μεσογείου, διακηρύπτουμε ὅτι ὑποστηρίζουμε μιά γρήγορη καὶ δίκαιη λύση τοῦ Κυπριακοῦ ζητήματος μέσαν τῶν διακοινοτικῶν συνομιλιῶν ύπό τήν αιγίδα τῶν Ἡνωμένων Ἐθνῶν, μέσα στὰ πλαίσια τῶν κατευθυντήριων γραμμῶν Μακαρίσου—Ντεκτάς, τῆς συμφωνίας Κυπριανοῦ—Ντεκτάς καὶ τῶν σχετικῶν ἀποφάσεων τῶν Ἡνωμένων Ἐθνῶν.

Χαιρετίζουμε τήν ἐπανάληψη τῶν διακοινοτικῶν συνομιλιῶν. Ζητοῦμε τή δημιουργία τῆς κατάλληλης ὄτιμοσφαιρας μέ τήν εἰσαγωγή πρακτικῶν μέτρων τά όποια θά ἀναπτύξουν ἀμοιβαία ἐμπιστοσύνη ἀνάμεσα στίς κοινότητες καὶ θά κάμουν δυνατό ὀστέο εἰς ἐκπρόσωποι διαφόρων ἀπόψεων κι ἀπό τίς δυό κοινότητες νά ἔλθουν μαζί καὶ νά δρουν κοινό ἔδαφος γιά νά θεωρήσουν τούς συνομιλητές στήν προσπάθειά τους νά φτάσουν σέ μιά γρήγορη διευθέτηση.

Ζητοῦμε τόν σεβασμό τῆς ἀνεξαρτησίας, τῆς κυριαρχίας, τῆς ἔδαφικῆς ἀκεραιότητας καὶ τοῦ ἀδέσμευτου τῆς Κύπρου καὶ ή νέα ὁμοσπονδιακή δημοκρατία πού θά δημιουργηθεῖ νά ἔχει ἐπαρκεῖς ἐγγυήσεις ἐνάντια στήν ἔνωση ὄλοκληρης ἡ μέρους τῆς νήσου μέ όποιαδήποτε ὄλλη χώρα ἡ διαιρελισμό ὄποιου δήποτε εἰδούς.

Θό ἀγωνιστοῦμε γιά τήν κατάργηση τῶν βρετανικῶν βάσεων πού συνιστοῦν μεγάλο κίνδυνο γιά τούς Κυπρίους, Ἐλληνες καὶ Τούρκους καὶ γιά τούς λαούς τῆς περιοχῆς.

Πόθεος ὅλων τῶν Κυπρίων εῖναι νά κάμουν τήν ὅμορφη νήσο μιά νήσο δημοτική ἀπό ὅλα τά έντα στρατεύματα καὶ βάσεις, μιά πλήρως ἀποστρατικοποιημένη χώρα, μιά γένεφυρα εἰρήνης, φιλίας καὶ συνεργασίας σ' αὐτή τήν ταραχγμένη περιοχή τοῦ κόσμου.
